On 15 March 2005, Karen Naismith Robertson of the North Dorset Green Party presented a national 'TETRA and Phone Mast Forum' in Gillingham, Dorset, UK. The event was filmed and made into a DVDROM to make the information available to the wider public.

Together the Speakers presented the audience with the latest planning law, human rights, environmental, political, medical and scientific views available.

Among the audience were officials from the Police Federation, the Fire Brigades Union, County and District level government departments responsible for finance and planning and several mast campaign groups.
