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## Dear participant,

As an organisation, we have been receiving information that indicates there are many people across the country suffering ill health as a result of GSM, 3G or/and TETRA antennae being installed near their homes.

We are aware of the need to capture the information that people are becoming ill, but our frustration has been our inability to raise adequate funds for a full epidemiological study to address this problem effectively. This is what is required. This is what should be done but the government is ignoring this obvious need.

## Our goals are to:

- 1. Accurately reflect the number of people across the United Kingdom that believe the mobile phone or TETRA antennae have been the cause of them experiencing microwave sickness and other more serious illness'.
- 2. Raise awareness for those that are 'suffering in ignorance', that microwave sickness is not "in their heads or imaginations" but a legitimate ill health consequence of exposure to microwave radiation that has been known about by various governments for many years.
- 3. Work with the media to turn up the pressure on the government, by providing the numbers of people affected across the country leading to:
  - Funding for full independent epidemiological study of people living around masts
  - Immediate implementation of more stringent precautionary principle around siting of base stations/antennae that results in the establishment of an exclusion zone.

## Background to this health survey. . .

To achieve these goals, we are backing a health survey that was initiated by a member of the public, who had directly suffered as a result of living next to mobile phone masts. This woman has Multiple Sclerosis and was able to directly link the rapid acceleration of her disease with the exposure to microwave radiation. Her Neurologist is in agreement.

She realised that in order for the survey to have any credibility with authorities, it would need to be independent and as unbiased as possible, and that the information collected needed to be legally protected. As a result, this individual offered her own small business - a limited company as a mechanism for collecting the research data. She expanded the scope of the company to include "research", conformed to certain Data Management rules required under the DPA and applied for and received registration under the Data Protection Act to hold the Health Survey Data. She then co-ordinated the development of the survey with several health professionals. This was all done and continues to be done on a no-fee voluntary basis.

She is the individual who will be responsible for entering the data and providing the resultant "figures and geographical locations" to the public. The statistical results of the survey will be available to the public - including Action groups / industry and Government.

No individual information will be identified. Geographical locations will be given by position in the county i.e., North, South, East or West. Individual town or city names will not be provided as this could enable investigative reporters to potentially trace the source to an individual.

Receiving this survey does not necessarily mean we believe there is a cluster in your area. We are not just looking at areas where there is already reported ill health. We are open minded about the fact that there maybe many masts that have no effect on the people around them. Many factors may be involved in the ill health clusters that we have found already. However we need to find those areas that maybe "safe" and in that respect even if you are having no symptoms your reply will be of great use.

We are in a catch 22 situation at the moment. We can't do a full study until we have funding; we can't get funding until we show a problem. Whilst we don't have that information we cant discover if clusters of ill health are exasperated by other factors as well as the masts. So please consider participating even if you do not believe you are suffering as a result of the mast nearby, your answers will still be incredibly useful.

We hope you will participate.
